Hockey is a game that is played with a Stick and ball. There are 11 players on each side. This game has been played for thousands of years all over the world such as Egypt, Greece, Rom, South America and Asia. Historical records show that Hockey was played in Egypt 4000 years ago, various museums offer evidences that a form of the game was played by the romans and Greeks. Aztec (2017) argues that Indians and South Americans as well as in several other countries hockey was played before Columbus Landed in the new world (Britannica, 2020).

The hockey was first played at the Olympic Games in 1908, the hockey was played at the commonwealth Games for the first time in 1998. The federation international de Hockey (F.I.H.) was established in 1909. The women's games developed quickly in many countries and in 1927, the International Federation of women's Hockey association (IFWHA) was formed, the (F.I.H) in 1974 and the

(IFWHA) in 1980. These two organizations came together in 1982 to form the FIH. This game was played in subcontinent Asia.

After the foundation of Pakistan this game was early introduced in 1948 where the Pakistan Hockey federation (PHF) was established. The game hockey was originally brought to Pakistan during the British Raj, and like cricket, became a popular sport among the local population. The Pakistan Hockey Federation came into being in 1948. The Pakistan team had won many medals including international, Olympic medal. Pakistan team was the one of the best teams in the world. The Pakistan is a record achiever country who has won world hockey world cup many times. There is no country that has won hockey world cup for four times. The researcher is eager to know the cause of less popularity of the game that was once favorite game of Pakistan.

The Pakistan had won the gold medal in Rome in 1960 first time after the independence of Pakistan. Pakistani team was defeated in 1964 by India in final. Pakistani teem after the four year in 1968 in Mexico again got gold medal. Last achievement of Pakistani team was winning of hockey world cup in 1994. So the researcher is eager to know the causes of downfall of the game and also the loss of prestige of Pakistani hockey team.

Hockey is the national game of Pakistan but this is the game that is declining day by day in Pakistan. There have been few researches conducted on the core issues behind the decline of hockey. Here, the present research aims to know the causes of those factors which contribute downfall of the hockey in Pakistan. The problems and their solution is very necessary if hockey is to achieve place that is lost.

Literature Review

Torlak (2019) is of the view that hockey is a national game of Pakistan that is suffering a great deal of decline at the hands of government as the government is not funding properly. Financial support is a factor influencing the progress and success of the hockey. Moreover, Shabani & Hasani, (2017) asserts that fund raising is essential for advancement of major sporting activities. Humhrey (2010) suggested that revenues were the main factor in all professional sports. In addition, financial issues have a remarkable effect on the incomes obtained from executive sports league and sponsorships. Disturbance of income spill, because of budgetary issues, can influence hereafter games provision restoration. Financial sectors neglected at shocking costs and the rates of reliability deal on big board cut down worldwide. Pakistan field hockey has been facing financial issues from the last two decades (The News, 2016). Ali et al. (2013) suggested that countries facing shortage of sports facilities, infrastructure, poor coaching, and insufficient sports equipment was due to lack of financial resources. Lack of financial resources were a fundamental cause of decline in sports worldwide.

According to Ali, F., Omar, R., & Amin, M. (2013) Pakistani hockey has been facing with severe decline for the last two decades. According to Bhatti (2013) and Haji Hasani, M. (2017).) Pakistani hockey grieved a main shock. A team that was once four times title winner remained unsuccessful for its participation in the World Cup 2014.

The big matter which was faced to the Pakistani players was lack of proper training and coaching. Pakistani hockey players were generally coached by few trainers or coaches. There were many chances to remain many things uncertain, this caused the instability to the players and in their performance. In the same way many other causes were faced by the hockey players that became cause of decline of hockey in Pakistan.

Hypothesis

Hockey was once the most favorite played and viewed in Pakistan but with the passage of time its importance has been decreased and suddenly it has almost vanished. It is the national game of Pakistan that is undergoing a downfall at the present moment and its significance is decreasing day by day instead of increasing.

Material and Methods

Researcher has applied the quantitative approach of methodology to find out the "causes of decline of hockey in Pakistan". Secondly they showed that declined in hockey was due to unavailability of Astor trough ground where 63% population said yes. On the other hand the viewers were of the view that there is great role of the media for decline in hockey. The viewer was given statement that sports TV channels are less as compare to other countries where 63% said yes that in Pakistan has less sports channels. The results also show that merits are not practiced in Pakistan for the selection of the players. Viewers are also of the view that hockey is not played from the root level in Pakistan they were 62%.

In Pakistan the future of the players is not bright. Pakistani staff for hockey players is not fully trained 55% population said yes. The clubs in Pakistan for the training of the players were less due to that case hockey was declined here 67% population agreed with this statement. Another statements the viewer said Pakistan hockey player's selection is not from the initial level where the 67% agreed with this question. Pakistan hockey declined due to the involvements of the politics 54% population agreed with this statements. Lastly the viewers agreed with the statement that in Pakistan there are potential to grow in hockey in Pakistan 62% population were in favor of this view. So the researcher found out the causes of decline of hockey in Pakistan, by adopting these causes in the field of hockey the institution which deals with hockey organizations in Pakistan.

Recommendations

Hockey in Pakistan can be improved if few changes should be adopted. The researcher found that there were many changes required for the promotions of hockey in Pakistan few of them which researcher found were very important these were as "Pakistani administrator should assure the availability of required funds, they should construct Astor Trough grounds, train their staff, clubs should be opened at root level, selections of the players must be from initial level clubs and totally on the merit basis on the best performance of the players. The remuneration of the players should be according to their requirements. If these suggestions be are adopted there are some prospectuses that future of hockey in Pakistan will be bright.
